

Toileting – Pay Grade 8

To be considered for the higher rate of pay for toileting, the EA would be exposed to and comes in contact with bodily fluids. Therefore, the EA must wear protective gloves. The EA physically changes soiled underwear and outerwear, washes the student, and changes the student's clothing when necessary.

Taking the student to the washroom and waiting while the student uses the toilet and cleans himself would not be considered toileting.

Indicating toileting on your time sheet and having your Resource Teacher verify that you did glove up and clean the student will earn the higher rate of pay for that day.

Once a threshold of toileting 10 times has been reached, a review will be conducted. If it is determined that you will continue toileting on a regular basis for the rest of the school year, you may be awarded the higher rate of pay.
